The Whatcom County Sheriff's Office is accepting applications for the 2018 Citizens Academy. The Citizens Academy is designed to provide an opportunity for the Sheriff's Office to interact with its citizens and educate them about the law enforcement agency that serves their community and allow its citizens to have a better understanding of law enforcement.

The academy will meet every Tuesday evening from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM starting on Tuesday, September 4th and concluding with a graduation ceremony on Tuesday, November 20th. The Academy will be held in two locations and will cover many topics such as, K-9 demonstrations, use of force training, crime scene investigation, traffic enforcement, patrol procedures, investigations, corrections, prosecutor and public defenders offices, and much more.

The academy will be limited to 30 participants. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older, live in Whatcom County, be able to commit to the time requirements, and must pass a basic background check.
